



The project links together two suburban centres by spaces formed with buildings in contact with nature. The buildings are orientated north-south, facing away from the traffic towards the sun, the hill and the vegetation, and allowing the sun to flood the street. Qualities like good lighting and harmonious proportions make the rooms of the apartments multi-functional and flexible. There is no need for public functions in the area at the moment but the project provides for future extensions of small shops and small-scale workshops/ businesses at street level
